How to locate "Ephesians" in your physical Bible:

1. Go to the front of your Bible to the **Table of Contents**
2. Go to the New Testament Section
3. Run your finger down until you see "Ephesians" and note the page it starts on
4. Go to the Book of Ephesians. You will see large, bold, numbers. These are the Chapters.
Find Chapter 2
5. Run your finger down to 8.
6. You are there!!!! Ephesians Chapter 2, verse 8. Written as Ephesians 2:8

Power Scripture:

For by grace are you saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

Ephesians 2:8
