Definitions:

Type: The form, kind, sort, or nature. To represent beforehand as a prefigure. To produce a copy of, to represent.

Greek: parobole (par-ab-ol-ay). A comparing, comparison of one thing with another, likeness, similitude, an example by which a doctrine or precept is illustrated.

Shadow: A trace of an object, a reflected image, usually within defined limits, obscure within a space from which rays from a source of light are cut off by an interposed object.

Law of first mentioned: The first time a subject is mentioned in the Bible.

Law of last mentioned: The last time a subject is mentioned in the Bible.

Other times mentioned: For better understanding and to put things in context sometimes it is necessary to search the Bible to find other times the subject you are studying is mentioned.
