### Correction in Scripture

**Repentance:** Strongs G3341 - metanoia, pronounced: met-an'-oy-a

a change of mind, as it appears to one who repents, of a purpose he has formed or of something he has done

**Hebrews 6:1,2** Therefore, leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection, not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God, of the doctrine of baptisms and of laying on of hands, and of resurrection of the dead and of eternal judgment.

2. **Zechariah 1:3** Therefore say thou unto them: Thus saith the Lord of hosts: 'Turn you unto Me,' saith the Lord of hosts, 'and I will turn unto you,' saith the Lord of hosts. Teshuvah, return to God.
3. **1 John 1:9** If we confess our sins, He(God) is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.
